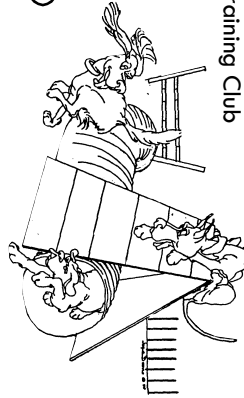
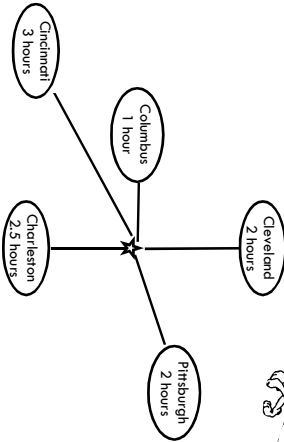

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class to plan their strategy. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class. Walk-throughs will be held prior to the Novice, Open, and Excellent classes.

Awards

Titling Classes: A green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to qualifying dogs placing 1st thru 4th (who will also receive a dog toy valued at up to \$5) and to those completing titles. Double Q and Triple Q ribbons are awarded for all dogs earning a QQ or QQQ from the Excellent B classes only. A large rosette, MACH bar, and MACH prize will be awarded to any team completing a MACH title. A large rosette & PAX bar will be awarded to any team completing a PAX title. All awards must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed.

Exhibitor Information

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group, but not with their or their dogs' names. Group banners may be displayed, but shall be placed so that movement of the banners does not distract the dogs on the course.

Junior Handlers

PLEASE be sure to indicate on the entry form whether a Junior handler will be running the dog, and include their JH number. It is now required to include this in the AKC catalogs, and addition after scoring of a trial has begun is difficult!

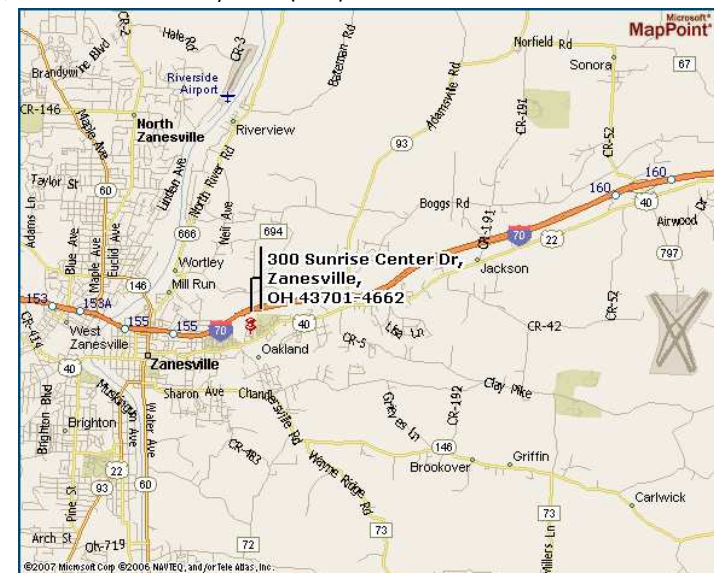
Directions to the Trial and Show Site Information

Food and indoor restrooms will be available at the show site.

Overnight RV parking & camping at the show site is permitted (NO FEE); there is plenty of space. However, no services are available. Contact the Trial Chair if you have specific questions. No dogs may be left unsupervised overnight at the show site, but crates/ex-pens/shelters may be left at the owner's risk.

Please clean up after your dogs! This show is being held at a fitness center. **No dogs are allowed in the restrooms!**

Directions: From the East, take I-70 to Exit 157; turn left (South) on SR-93 for 0.2mi; then turn right (West) onto US-22/US-40. Travel West for 1.1mi; Sunrise Center will be on your right (North). From the West, take I-70 to Exit 155 for OH-60S/OH-146E. Bear left onto Elberon Ave; go 0.1mi, and turn right (South) onto OH-60S/146E. Travel 0.2mi and turn left (East) onto US-22/US-40. Travel East for 1.2mi; Sunrise Center will be on your left (North).



Notice to Exhibitors

Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **Puppies** under 6 months of age are prohibited from the show grounds.

All dogs must be on leash or confined except when being judged or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

*****Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on an official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with signed Agreement and Instructions attached cannot be accepted.*****

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Express delivery entries** must include a signature permitting them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address without the recipient's signature. If no recipient is present to sign receipt, entries may be returned to sender.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary. Confirmation of acceptance will be made if either an email address or a self-addressed, stamped postcard with checkboxes for each class entered is included with the entry.

Owners are responsible for **errors made while filling out entry forms**, whoever makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully to minimize errors! Every effort will be made to find all **duplicate entries**; however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Make all checks and money orders **payable to POTC** in US funds only. Please mail fees with entries. The Trial Secretary and POTC assume no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **Post-dated or returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$20 service charge for returned checks.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. No fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed in the event of riots, civil disturbances, fire, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. **Entry fees less \$5 per run will be refunded for injured dogs or bitches in season** on the day of the trial if veterinary certification is presented by the close of the final trial of the weekend. Overpayment of less than \$5 will not be refunded except at the exhibitor's request.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. Handlers are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when it is their turn to run. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Parkersburg Obedience Training Club, Inc., and its agents assume **no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury** sustained by exhibitors, handlers, their dogs or property, or their children.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registrable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial-giving club is allowing the option of mixed breed entries.

AVMA Health Statement

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

Class Information (see also Chapters 6-9 of the Regulations for Agility Trials)

The following levels and divisions are offered for Standard, JWW, and FAST classes:

All dogs entering Preferred classes for the first time must enter at the Novice level; there is no grandfathering of Regular titles. **Dogs must be entered only in Preferred or in Regular classes**, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials.

Obstacles

All obstacles are as specified in the "Regulations for Agility Trials" from the American Kennel Club, amended to September 2006 (and at www.akc.org).

**** 24" spaced weave poles and rubberized contact surfaces will be used at the trial.****

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the **Dogs To Be Measured List**. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. It is solely the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the correct measurement box, enter your dog(s) in the correct jump height, have your dog(s) measured before running (if necessary), and to have your dog(s) height card(s) available to present, if requested.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All heights are as measured at the withers.

Regular Class (Preferred Class) jump height divisions:

8(4)inches..... for dogs 11 inches and under	20(16)inches ..for dogs 22 inches and under
12(8)inches.... for dogs 14 inches and under	24(20)inches ..for dogs over 22 inches
16(12)inches.. for dogs 18 inches and under	26 inchesat owner's discretion (n/a Preferred)

Dogs entered in **Preferred** classes must jump at a height 4" lower than the minimum height they would be required to jump in Regular classes as listed above.

Random Draw

Entries accepted no sooner than Wednesday, February 10th at 8am; **finish date** for entry into the random draw opening period is Wednesday, February 24th at 4pm.

Random draw will be held on Thursday, Feb 25th at 7pm, at the Trial Secretary's home (see pg2).

Entries close 4pm Tuesday, April 6th. If entry limits are not reached during the opening period, they will be filled on a "first received" basis until the closing date.

Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary for the random draw. Envelopes containing entries for more than 10 dogs shall be treated as an invalid entry and will be returned.

In the event an envelope is drawn that contains entries that would exceed the entry limit, there will be a random draw of the individual entries contained therein to fill the specified entry limit.

If the entry limit is reached during the draw, all remaining entries shall be drawn for a position on the waitlist.

All Random Draw rules and regulations as they appear in Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Regulations for Agility Trials shall apply.

Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner. This request must be made to the Trial Secretary by 6pm on Monday, April 19th, by mail or e-mail (see form on p.9). Requests for day-to-day move-ups must be made to the Secretary before the close of trial on the preceding day.

Confirmations and Entry Changes

Per AKC regulations, changes to entries may be made until the closing date. After that time, only moveups are permitted until the moveup deadline. Corrections to entries due to Secretarial error may be requested until the moveup deadline without fee; after that date, a \$5 per dog correction fee will be assessed. Preliminary confirmations will be emailed within 7 days of receipt of your entry if a valid email address is provided; PLEASE be sure to add TrialSec@furrydogs.com to your address book/whitelist to ensure the email reaches you, so you can check your information promptly!

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or **back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs entered must list the breed name as "Mixed Breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club at (919)816-3776.
