Hello everyone, and welcome to the 1st Annual Parkersburg Dog Training Club NADAC Agility Trials... we hope you enjoy yourselves and that we see all of you again next year (check www.furrydogs.com for updates to this and future trials)! Also note that any move-ups are due no later than **4pm on Monday, June 12th**.

Please plan your arrival accordingly (allow 5-10 minutes to get to the show site once you exit from I-77); also many of you were generous enough to volunteer your time to work at our trial; you will also receive a worker assignment schedule in email or paper mail so that you can plan your weekend.

Check-in & Measuring: If you did not submit a copy of a jump height card (indicated on your confirmation page), please bring your card to the check-in table or be prepared to have your dog measured **prior to running** - please plan to allow some extra time to do this prior to the start of judging. We will NOT have a height card measuring judge present - all dogs w/o a height card **MUST** be measured, except those jumping 20" or 20+ (or Vet/JH jumping 16"). We will be measuring from 7-7:45am each day.

followed by Jumpers - Elite, then Open, then Novice

followed by Regular1/Regular2 - both Elite rounds, then both Open rounds, then both Novice rounds

followed by Tunnelers - Elite, then Open, then Novice

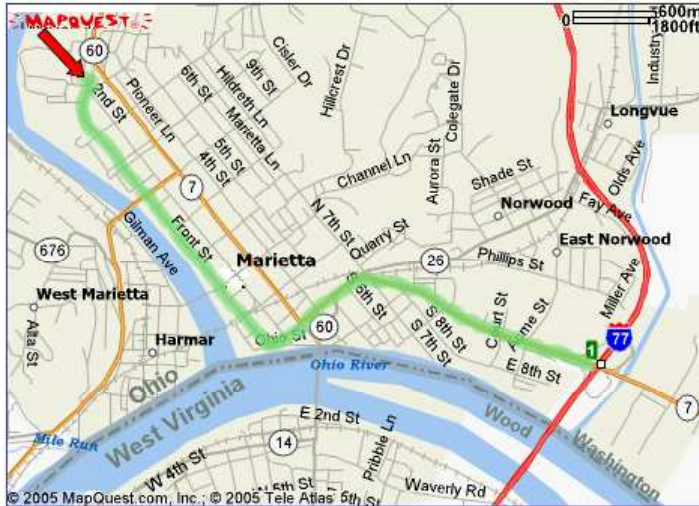
****Lunch break to be taken at the judge's discretion****

- Standard, Vets, and JH will run together by height, in all classes and skill levels.
- Running order: 4" to 20+" both days
- Walkthroughs may be split as needed (not yet determined).
- No collars may be worn per NADAC Regulations.

Show Site Info and Directions:

Food and indoor restrooms will be available at the show site.

Overnight RV parking & camping at the show site is permitted; electric hookups available at \$20/day; please contact Trial Chairperson if questions. No dogs may be left unsupervised overnight at the show site, but crates/ex-pens/shelters may be left at the owner's risk. We will be setting up on Friday evening; please plan to be there by 7:30pm if you plan to set up your equipment that evening.



There is plenty of covered crating space; however, indoor space may be limited. Please see the photos (www.furrydogs.com) of the "covered porch" area surrounding the building.

Please clean up after your dogs! This show is being held at a county fairground. **No dogs are allowed in the restrooms!**

Directions: From N or S, take I-77 to Exit 1 (Marietta), then westward on SR-7 South (Newport Pike) for ~1.1 miles; bear left at the 3-way intersection as road becomes Greene St (SR-60) & continue ~0.5mi to Front St (Hotel Lafayette will be straight ahead). Turn right onto Front; stay in right lane & continue straight for ~1.6 mi; the Fairgrounds will be on your left.

Hotel Info: Many area hotels accept well-mannered dogs and handlers; some may charge additional fees for pets, so please call ahead to verify acceptance. Please clean up after your pets at the hotels! They

are considered extensions of the show site, and we have requested these properties to notify us of any problems so that appropriate actions may be taken. The Best Western is closest to the show site; Parkersburg hotels are the farthest (although only ~10 minutes farther). A list is available in the premium.

If you get lost on Saturday... we will try to remember to have our cell phones turned on (no guarantees!)
